<b>Gold</b>	<b>AIM HIGH!</b> ↑	A variety of sentence lengths and types. Wide range of conjunctions used, e.g. although, meanwhile, however	
		Use connectives to give clear links between paragraphs.	
		Use a wide range of punctuation including speech punctuation.	
		Ideas and descriptions are developed using imaginative detail. Figurative language used (similes, metaphors, personification).	
Vocabulary is wide & chosen for its effect on the reader.			
<b>Silver</b>		Simple, compound and complex sentences are used. Use of if, when, because to create subordinate clauses.	
		Basic links between paragraphs are used, e.g. firstly, next, finally.	
		Sentence punctuation is accurate. Speech punctuation and commas for clauses are used.	
		Some ideas are developed in detail, e.g. using adjectives and adverbs on their own and in phrases.	
		Vocabulary is chosen to deliberately fit the story.	
<b>Bronze</b>		Mainly simple sentences. Most common connectives are and, but & so.	
		Ideas are organised into paragraphs.	
	Straightforward sentences are punctuated accurately. Some use of speech punctuation.		
	There is some attempt to expand on basic information.		
	Simple, appropriate vocabulary is used.
