sat **on** a tuffet,

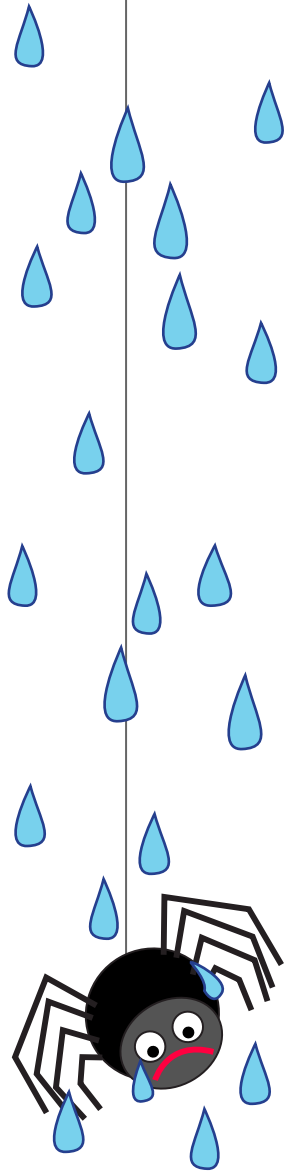
eating her curds and whey.

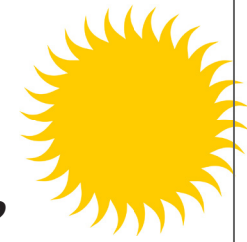
